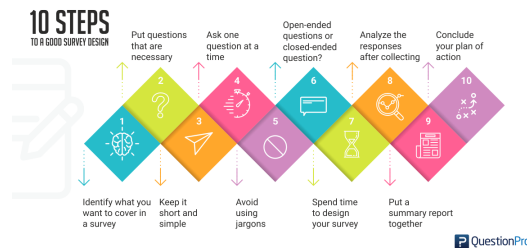

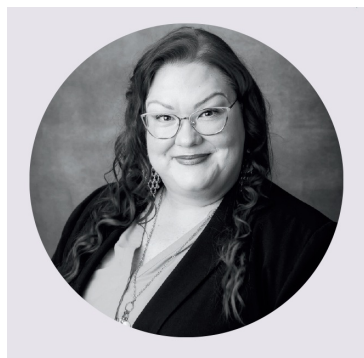

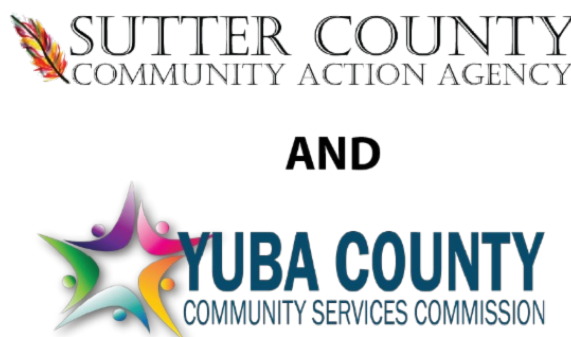
A New Vision for Healing: Meredith Evans Joins Hope Haven
